Announcing - "The Coachmen" to Reunite For One Performance Only !!!



Fifty-two years have passed since six St James Junior Classmen, all former members of the St Michael's Boys Choir, got together under the guidance of Father Martin Cullen and formed a singing group they called **The Coachmen**. Folk groups were the rage in early 1963 and the six thought it would be fun to give it a try themselves. Pat Curran, Chuck Pelzl, Jim Farmer, Mike Blackmun, Tim Hjelmstad and John Wavra, all St Mike's grads, got together in the basement of St Michael's Church and started to sing folk songs together for the first time. At the start, Pat Curran was the only member who could play a musical instrument or read music. Eventually Famer and Blackmun took up the guitar and banjo, which added to the group's sound and Pelzl and Wava continued to contribute with their "great voices".

After the first couple of singing gigs, Tim Hjelmstad decided he did not have the time to learn new songs or to practice regularly and dropped out of the group. The remaining five continued to sing together at senior living centers, St Michael's Altar Society, the Westward Ho, the Grand Forks Country Club and school events or any other venue they could find over the next year or more. A few were even paying gigs! With the rising popularity of the Beatles and rock music, the public soon lost its taste for folk music. The members of the group eventually decided to break up the group and after graduation in 1964 never sang together again.

Now, after 50 years, the 50th Reunion Committee "talked" the five Coachmen into reforming the group to make just one more appearance at the 50th Reunion of the St James Class of 1964 dinner. The former Coachmen joked that the notice of their appearance might cause some classmates to cancel their reservations to attend the dinner. They all agreed that unless we have at least 75 classmates and/or guests at the reunion dinner, counting themselves, they will refuse to perform. Let's all hope they have at least one opportunity meet before the dinner for a quick rehearsal!

As with all our classmates, life has taken the five remaining Coachmen in many different directions. Chuck Pelzl and John Wavra, both retired, live in Omaha, NE and see each other regularly. Pat Curran lives in Moorhead, MN and is retired. Jim Farmer, retired after many years working at casinos and lives In South Lake Tahoe, CA and teaches grade school part-time. Mike Blackmun teaches aviation at UND in Grand Forks and continues to perform in a band at a drinking establishment he co-owns in Grand Forks. The five have remained friends for the last fifty years. The last news of Tim Hjelmstad was that he was living in British Columbia, Canada. Tim is one of our "Lost" classmates as a recent mailing to his last known address was returned.


